### WHEN DO WE NEED THEM...

### WHAT GIFTS CAN I BUY....

- **PLEASE ENSURE THEY ARE NOT WRAPPED.**
- **Infants:** items need to be **fire safe** and have **approval codes**,
- **2 – 4yrs** Sleepwear, beach towels, hats, dolls, Character related toys (ie – Thomas the Tank Engine, Wiggles, Disney Characters)
- **4 – 8 yrs:** Jigsaws, dolls, picture books, car sets, trucks or cars, Leggo, simple models or puzzles.
- **8 – 12yrs:** Scrap booking, painting kits, jewellery making, Puzzles, Model making, sporting goods (balls, kits, bats etc)
- **Teenagers :** Beach Towels, bright toilet bags, Caps and accessories Boys – backpacks; toiletries (skincare/body sprays); wallets; sports balls; caps, music vouchers .
- **Battery operated toys** are generally not a great idea, due to the cost of batteries to keep them going. So if you choose to purchase a gift that requires batteries, please **include the batteries**.
